

HOW TO FIND US



FROM BRIGHTON: Take the A27 signposted Hastings as far as Pevensey. Follow A259 towards Bexhill until you come to a roundabout in the village of Little Common. Turn right and follow the road for one mile. The hotel is right on the beachfront.



FROM EASTBOURNE: Take the A259 signposted Bexhill until you come to a roundabout in the village of Little Common. Turn right and follow the road for one mile. The hotel is right on the beachfront.

FROM HASTINGS: Take the A259 signposted Bexhill until you come to a roundabout in the village of Little Common. Turn left and follow the road for one mile. The hotel is right on the beachfront.

FROM LONDON - EAST: Take the M25 to Junction 5, the A21. Follow the A21 into Hastings. Take the A259 signposted Bexhill until you come to a roundabout in the village of Little Common. Turn left and follow the road for one mile. The hotel is right on the beachfront.

FROM LONDON - WEST: Take the M25 to Junction 7, the M23. Follow the M23 and then the A23 to Brighton. Take the A27 signposted Lewes/Hastings as far as Pevensey. Take the A259 signposted Bexhill until you come to a roundabout in the village of Little Common. Turn right and follow the road for one mile. The hotel is right on the beachfront.
